Color in a Bag



Materials:

- 1 cup cornstarch
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 4 cups cold water
- Food coloring
- 2 gallon-size ziplock bags
- Duct tape

Instructions

1. Over medium heat, combine the cornstarch, sugar, and water in a saucepan, stirring continuously.

2. Once the mixture begins to thicken, remove the pan from the heat and stir for another minute or so until it thickens to a pudding like consistency. Let it cool for 30 minutes.

3. Spoon the mixture into two bowls, stir a few drops of food coloring into each (we used red and yellow), then divide the colors between the ziplock bags. Seal the bags with duct tape and let your child mix and mash the colors

Paper Sand Dollars



Materials

White or cream-colored card stock

Round cotton pad or circle of packing foam

Glue

Clothes pins

Dry barley

Instructions

1. To make your own paper sand dollars, first cut a pair of circles,



about 3 inches in diameter, from white or cream-colored card stock.

2. Sandwich the 2 circles together with a round cotton pad or circle of packing foam between them.

3. Glue the circles together, using clothes pins to hold them in place until the glue has dried.

4. Finally, glue on a star-shaped design of dry barley, as shown.
